





▲ Damage Requiring Service : This equipment from the power source and source and refer servicing to qualified service personnel under the following conditions

- (a) when the power is damaged.
- (b) if liquid has been spoiled or objects have hallen into the unit
- ⓒ if the equipment has been exposed to rain or water.
- (d) if the equipment has been dropped or otherwise damaged.
- (e) when the equipment exhibits a distinct change in performance- this indicates a need for service.


- ① Front panel
- ② Mounting Holes
- 3 Speaker : Transmits sounds from the household
- (4) Camera Lens : keep cleaning up from dust or foreign substances.
- 5 LED Lamp : The LED lamp is turned on for clear view during night.
- 6 Microphone : For use when communicating with the household
- O Page Button : Used to page the household
- $(\ensuremath{\underline{8}})$  Door release cable : Connect with door release switch
- (9) Monitor cable : Connect with household monitor after matching up the polarity



- 1. Cout out the MOUNTING TEMPLATE included in the manual and use it to drill mounting holes(Ø6.5) on the wall. insert Concrete anchors in the holes.
- 2. Wire the household monitor cables as shown below with matched polarity as picture below. [FIG-2]

(#1:RED/VOICE, #2:BLUE/GND, #3:YELLOW/DC12V, #4:BLACK/VIDEO)

- 3. Connect the door release cable as picture below. [FIG-2]
- 4. For exposed wiring, organize the wiring through the case as shown below.[FIG-3]
- 5. Secure using bolts and cover with AL.Screw Covers. [FIG-4]




